Background Information: For the third year we are attending camp with a church group called Foursquare. Melissa Smith grew up in a Foursquare church in Barron, and their beliefs align very closely with Wesleyan beliefs. Wesleyan does not have a regional kids camp at this time. Melissa's father-in-law, David Smith, is the children's pastor at Barron Foursquare. Sam Smith will be driving a bus to Camp Wapo with camp attendees from both Spooner Wesleyan and Barron Foursquare. Campers/leaders from other Foursquare churches in midwest MN/WI will be attending this camp. The River, a Wesleyan church in Minong, has also shown interest in attending, and may have some campers too! Melissa will be attending the camp as a camp leader. Sam Smith, Noah Smith, and Carson Klein will be attending as cabin leaders/helpers as well.

I don't go to a Wesleyan or Foursquare church, can my son or daughter still go to this camp?

Absolutely. We recognize the need to organize and implement a week-long spiritual camp retreat where children have fun while learning what it means to walk in the footsteps of Jesus. We welcome any and all children to experience this wonderful week.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Enter the link
2. Who are you registering:
 - a. Register my children (17 and younger)
 - i. Select how many of your children you are registering
 - ii. Enter the name(s) of your child(ren)
 - b. Register myself (18 and older). Use this if you personally will be attending the week of camp (camp staff)
3. First Time Users will need to sign up for a family account.
 - a. Email address or continue with google/facebook sign in
 - b. Account Sign up Information:
 - i. Parent/Guardian name, birthday, phone number, address
 - ii. You will create a new password
 - c. Name of Home Congregation (DO NOT TYPE SPOONER WESLEYAN)
 - i. OTHER/NOT LISTED
 - ii. Enter Church Name - FOURSQUARE (The church we are going through)
 - d. Ethnic questions can be answered if you would like
 - e. "Is there a court order in place that lists certain persons who are not authorized to pick up your child?" If yes, please list first and last name of individual(s). Please also inform the leader of the church you are registering with who the individual(s) are.
4. Register a "New Attendee"
 - a. Name, birthday, grade, gender
 - b. Name of Home Congregation (DO NOT TYPE SPOONER WESLEYAN)
 - i. OTHER/NOT LISTED
 - ii. Enter Church Name- FOURSQUARE (The church we are going through)
 - c. Ethnic questions can be answered if you would like
 - d. "Is there a court order in place that lists certain persons who are not authorized to pick up your child?" If yes, please list first and last name of individual(s). Please also inform the leader of the church you are registering with who the individual(s) are.
 - e. MEDICAL FORM
 - i. You will need your insurance information as well as dates of immunizations (if you have them)
 - ii. You will provide emergency contact information
 - iii. You will provide specific medication information including dosage. IF THIS CHANGES BEFORE CAMP it is easy to go back into your account and edit the medical form.
 - iv. OVER THE COUNTER medications that you take daily (ie allergy pill, melatonin, etc) should be brought in its original container to camp
 - v. OVER THE COUNTER medication that you would send for "just in case" such as tylenol, cough drops etc do not need to be sent to camp. The

nurse will have them in stock. Please be sure to select any medications listed on the form that you do NOT want your child to receive.

- f. Terms and Conditions
 - i. Please read through all of these terms and conditions before signing. If you have any questions please contact Melissa Smith at msmith@spoonerwesleyan.org, 218-590-6073
- g. If you have additional children to add select "Add Another Event/Camper"
- h. Select "Continue to Checkout"
- i. No balance will be due at online. All payment must be made in person at Spooner Wesleyan.
- j. Accept Terms and Conditions and continue
- k. Congratulations! You are now registered for MN/WI Kids Camp
 - i. After registration you will receive an email from Camp Wapo saying you have successfully registered. An email may also come if there is any missing information or if you began a registration and did not complete it.

Making changes to your account is easy. Visit lakewapo.org or use the original registration link. Log back into your account and go to "My Dashboard". From there you can edit information. This is especially helpful if there is a medication change.
